SICK CHILD POLICY

At Foundations For Learning your child's health is a matter of major importance to us all. To that end, all children attending this center should be free of contagious diseases, and all immunization records are to be in good standing. Children who have a fever, cough, or infection (throat, ear, eye, etc.) should not be brought to school. The staff will take the temperature of any child who seems ill during the school day. Any child running a fever of 101.5 degrees F° will be sent home and will not be able to return to the center for a period of 24 hours. The child must be symptom free before returning to the center.

Please keep your child home if....

- he/she has begun taking antibiotics in the last twelve hours
- he/she has a constant cough
- he/she has symptoms of a possible communicable disease (such as sniffles, reddened eyes, sore throat, headache, abdominal pain and fever).
- he/she has a rash or has had diarrhea or vomiting during the previous twelve (12) hour period.

If your child is suspected of having a contagious eye infection or rash, your child will be sent home and a Doctor's note stating that the child is not contagious will be required for your child to return to the center.

These policies are set in place to protect the health and safety of the children and staff of Foundations For Learning.
